THE ASSOCIATION'S DEPARTMENT LEADERS MEETING

On Friday, February 16, there was a meeting of leaders of the Association which took place at the Association headquarters. Brothers and sisters shared information about ministry accomplished during the months of December and January and discussed plans for the upcoming months.



The Summit of Russian-speaking Churches of Europe was formed for a more productive ministry and coordinating the work of Christian partnerships and associations.

The Summit of organizations working in Europe took place on February 20 to 23 in Urmala, Latvia. The motto of the summit were the words of prophet Isaiah: "How lovely
