NEWS OF ECB UNIONS FROM AROUND THE WORLD

The subscribers and readers of our newsletters could notice that we started to publish some news of ECB unions of various countries. We gather these news from websites of the unions or letters received from the leadership of these unions.

Unfortunately, not all of the unions publish their ministry information, and not all of them have it in Russian or English. For example, All-Ukrainian Union of ECB publishes information about the life of the union and partnering churches exclusively in Ukrainian. When we contacted the union's information department (Lyudmila Zhakun) with request about information in English or Russian, we were advised to find a volunteer in Ukraine or the U.S. who will be able to translate the news for us into Russian. Although it is a good suggestion, it is difficult for us to accomplish; so, at the moment, we cannot bring the life of this union to light on our website and in our newsletters. We are informing of this in order to avoid the possible misunderstandings and accusations of discrimination. We are in constant search for a translator. We will be very glad if anyone will be able to resolve this issue and could translate the news of Ukrainian churches and unions for us.
