TESTIMONY OF THE AMAZING WORKS OF GOD

A very astonishing message was posted on the prayer bulletin of the Russian Union of ECB:

«A prayer group from Moscow was praying monthly for the development of the international missions over the course of four years. Later, they found out that there was another prayer group in city of Ufa that was praying for two years for the same ministry. By coming in contact with the believers in Siberia, they learned that they also prayed for the same thing for many years. In March of this year (2017), during the pastors' meeting, Andrey Dzuba, who is the head pastor of the Central Church of the City of Ufa, was put in charge of the development of international missions in our union. Praise God for the answered prayers! »

While being in Jurmala on the 8th Summit-Forum of Russian-speaking ministers of Europe, Andrey Dzuba said: «We are amazed! PRAYER REQUEST

The following message was received from Kiev:

«We are coming to you with a prayer request! In Lugansk and its region, there was a very complicated development. The ministers of all confessions were called to the local authorities and told that all of the church buildings do not belong to them anymore, that the registration of new churches is now prohibited, and gathering in homes or anywhere else is not allowed! Adventists were announced as an extreme organization and are completely outlawed. The believers are taking everything that they can out of the church buildings while it is still possible. Everything is in huge disarray. Please pray for all of the brothers and sisters, and for the situation there! »
