Slavic Baptist Church of West Sacramento (pastor I. A. Verstak) hosted a fourth module of the International Institute of Biblical Counselors "Coram Deo". Twenty-four people from different churches in Sacramento, including one brother from Pennsylvania studied the section of training in "Applying Scriptures in Counseling". The goal of this module was to

keep the counselor from misapplying the Scriptures, to instruct and model the right approach of application, to study and understand the application of moving from the Law to the Gospel in the process of sanctification, to help the counselor how to accurately handle the Scriptures and to rebuke or encourage the counselee.
