Two sisters in the Lord, who are citizens of Kazakhstan and graduates of a Theological University in Kishinev, were deported from Jordan without the appeal to return. UPDATE ON THE MOSCOW THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

Since then the seminary has endured many audits, one of which concluded on September 18.
