There was a meeting of the chairmen of the Slavic associations of the U.S., the organizes of the Missionary Congress of **2021**. Did you notice the change of the year: instead of "2020" there is a new number "2021"? This is due to the limitations to gatherings of large events in California being extended to "indefinite times", and because of that, the following decision was reached: to reschedule the Congress to fall 2021. THIS YEAR ASSOCIATION CONVENTION


As the questions about the upcoming convention are beginning to trickle in, we want to inform you that the president of the Association and the committee are in constant communication about this issue. For now, it is unclear whether the government will allow big gatherings in October. Even if we invite only the church delegates, there will be over 200 people, which is twice more than what is allowed under the present guidelines.

Keeping the present restrictions in mind, the other associations and unions of ECB of America cancelled their conventions and rescheduled them until the following year. Perhaps that is the decision that our Association will have to make as well. Until then, the

committee continues the preparations in hopes that it will be allowed to take place as usual at the end of October of this year.

ANOTHER MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION'S DEPARTMENTS LEADERS

On June 26th, there was another ZOOM meeting of the Association's departments leaders. This is not the first meeting that took place in this format and it appears that the ZOOM meetings are becoming a new norm for everyone. During the meeting, the ministry leaders presented their reports. Although many of the planned conferences and church visits are still impossible, but the ministry continues through the online forms of communications such as ZOOM, Viber, Skype, and others. Although these platforms allow some opportunities for fellowship, everyone awaits with anticipation when it will be possible to meet face to face in person. We will continue to pray for that.






Remains of Several Apartments

HOW TO SURVIVE IN OUR TIMES?



THE JOURNEY OF OUR FATHERS AND MOTHERS

More and more of the prominent Christian leaders are talking about the coming mass persecutions of Christians. In a few countries, these persecutions never ended, but in America, which is a country of freedom and liberty, the persecution of Christians for their convictions has been illegal up to date.

In the last few decades, there has been a significant change in that regard. With the increase of liberalism of society and the government, there are more and more laws that are passed, which are in direct contradiction to God's standards. Eventually, the Christians will have to make a difficult decision: go with the flow or against it, to listen to God or the people. It is inevitable that there will be a price to pay for one's convictions, and perhaps that price may be extremely high.



Our fathers and mothers have already walked this path, the path of affliction and persecution. While living in good conditions, it is easy to forget what they experienced.
