#### **NEWS FROM SLAVIC THEOLOGICAL COLLEGIATE**

The Slavic Theological Collegiate was not sidestepped when it comes to important questions of many people. On May 1, its members held a ZOOM conference with the theme of "The Church in the Midst of a Pandemic". A <u>summarized</u> and <u>full</u> version of the recording is available on the YouTube channel.

On May 15, the same collegiate had a radio program with the theme of "Questionable Technology". This program has three versions of the recording:

- Short Version, 18 minutes in length. This recording covers only the technology.
- Since in the discussion of 5G technology has a reference to the Revelation of John, there is a separate material taken from a full program Revelation 13, and is 16 minutes in length.
- Full recording of "Questionable Technology", which is 1.5 hours in length.

#### BIBLICAL COUNSELING TRAINING

Over the course of a few years, the International Institute of Biblical Counseling "Coram Deo" tried to enroll a group of disciples in Sacramento. At first, the groups from many of our churches had a relatively large amount of people that consisted of pastors and other ministers of local churches. However, almost all of the pastors dropped out due to the business of the ministry, and the present group of students has only one deacon who is far from out of our state.

Unlike California, Germany has a completely different picture. The training is taking place for the 10th year in row and is attended by many preachers, deacons, and pastors. Why is there such a difference? That is what the leader of the Association's information ministry O. Avetisova tried to find out during the interview with E. Kolpakov, the headmaster of the institute in Germany. Watch an interview here.
