

MORE THAN 25% OF REGULAR CHURCH ATTENDEES ARE STILL NOT ATTENDING CHURCH REGULARLY

According to the survey conducted by AP-NORC, despite the fact that the pandemic restrictions are gradually being lifted, people are not rushing to return to churches. The Southern Baptist Convention, which is the largest Protestant denomination, recently reported that they lost a record number of people, about **400,000** in 2020 year. It is estimated that the decrease is due to less baptisms taking place during the pandemic, an increased number of deaths due to the virus, and a decrease of attendance of church members of individual churches.
