NEW ENROLLMENT FOR BIBLICAL COUNSELING TRAINING

59TH CONVENTION OF THE EURO-ASIAN FEDERATION OF ECB UNIONS

From October 4 to October 9, the 59th Convention of the Euro-Asian Federation of ECB Unions was held in Turkish Antalya. The forum brought together delegates from 14 countries: Azerbaijan, Belarus, Germany, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Moldova, Russia, USA, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Uzbekistan, and Scotland. Representatives of some countries that are members of the Federation could not come because of military operations in their countries.

The Convention elected and blessed the new leadership of the E-A Federation for the next two years. The current president of the Union of ECB Churches of Moldova, Nikolai Grigoryevich Vozian, became the President. Asatur Nagapetyan (Armenia) and Sergey Kondaurov (Kazakhstan) became Vice-Presidents. The service of the executive secretary of the Federation will continue to be carried out by Yuri Arkadyevich Apatov. NEWS FROM AROUND THE WORLD

WHAT DO TEENS THINK OF JESUS?

What do today's teenagers from different religious groups think about Jesus, the Bible, and justice? US-based Christian sociological organization Barna asked this question to nearly 25,000 teenagers in 26 countries and received encouraging responses.

"The data shows that teenagers rarely think badly of Jesus," says Barna, who found that most of them feel positively about Jesus: 49% of teenagers describe Jesus as "loving," 46% believe that Jesus brings hope to the people, and 43% say He cares about people. Only 8% said He was detached from today's real issues, 7% thought He was judgmental, 6% thought He is irrelevant, and 4% thought He was hypocritical.

THE TITLE OF PASTOR CAN ONLY BELONG TO MEN

The Seminary of the Southern Baptist Convention passed a resolution reaffirming its president's position that only men can be pastors, an indirect response to Rick Warren's Saddleback Church ordaining three female pastors last year.

At their fall meeting, the trustees of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky, unanimously approved a resolution urging the seminary administration to continue the theological training of both men and women, but only men are to be recognized as pastors.
