


APRIL NEWSLETTER - 2023 NEWS FROM THE DEPARTMENTS AND CHURCHES OF THE ASSOCIATION

EURASIA MINISTRY- URGENT PRAYER REQUEST ABOUT DENIS GORENKOV



In Atlanta, he established a global radio and television ministry that is able to reach people in 150 countries.


