

URGENT NEED IN SPAIN

Please, **pray for an urgent need** of receiving a license to have church services at Torrevieja, Spain.

The enemy is on the alert. Two families who live across from the missionary church (pastored by Victor Kovba) complained to the police that the church has loud music

and is gathering a lot of people. The police came three times and warned the church that if they did not get a license before **February 15, 2024**, then they will shut down the church building. They want to get the church out of their city. The Christian organization and the church itself are officially registered. Without the license and insurance, they are allowed to have no more than 30 people.

They do have the insurance, but not the license. Please pray so that the church would be able to file all the paperwork and find the finances for the license, which is 1,900 Euro. 
SIERRA PINES CAMP IS SERVING PEOPLE ONCE AGAIN



The team of Healthy Christian Ministry would like to serve all the women at this event!


