IF YOU HAD THE CHANCE to tell the world what Christmas was about, how would you go about it, and what would you say? Well, this is the challenge that our missionaries at New Life Radio have this month in December (as well as throughout the year). And it is a privilege that God has given us in partnership with all of you who help make it possible!

Since late October, the NLR staff has been busy producing vast amounts of Christmas-themed programs and compiling new musical archives that make our December 1 through January 7 Christmas program period interesting and compelling. Why January 7? That's when most Russians celebrate Christmas according to the old Julian calendar. How is it compelling? By revealing the totality of God's plan for mankind and the miracle of God deciding to reveal Himself to mankind through His Son, born in a manger, destined for the Cross, and reconciling us to Him for eternity. That sure is a Big story for a small group to work on!

As our team approaches Christmas, we realize there is a much confusion or lack of knowledge about the nature, person, and work of Christ. This month, a basic theme in our broadcasts centers on the discussion of Christology. Who is this Jesus we worship at Christmas? Why did He come, how is He God in the flesh, what does He want from us, what is our responsibility to Him; how do we read and interpret His words from the Gospel accounts? This is the core of the Christian faith, and we are constantly petitioning the Lord to give us the wisdom and insight on how to properly proclaim these fundamental truths to a skeptical Slavic people.

The HISTORY OF CHRISTIANITY on NLR



20 centuries of Christianity is the program theme of this series, hosted by Lina Stepanenko and featuring Roman Kalishnikov, a seminary professor from the *Odessa Theological Seminary*.



The program is designed to take our radio audience with little knowledge of the development of the Church to a clearer understanding of how believers lived and experienced the Christian life across the generations. Lina is our resident *investigative reporter* on Christianity and doctrinal issues. Each week, she effectively draws upon the expert knowledge of Roman, who loves his subject and gives very insightful and clear lessons on the growth of the Church, Christian doctrine as defined

and often challenged across time, and numerous themes of interest to anyone who seeks to understand how to live today as the first Christians lived and witnessed for Christ in their own day.

Programming note: NLR seeks to provide programs that offer historical, Scriptural, and deep theological discussion to provide the *meat* we seek to deliver to those who are ready for it. In the meantime, Roman's program gives many a starter course for understanding the history of our faith.
