Dear Olga,

As the situation in Ukraine becomes more dire by the moment, I am turning to you, our faithful partners and friends, to provide immediate physical and spiritual help for the people of Ukraine, who may be facing a full-scale war with Russia any day.

I urgently appeal to you to help Mission Eurasia provide:

- Emergency Food Packages—Mission Eurasia is making immediate preparations to deliver 2,000 emergency food packages to families in Ukraine who face the possibility of a humanitarian crisis if war breaks out. Each food package costs \$50 and contains enough food to sustain a family of four-five for a week. A Bible or other copy of Scripture will be included in the food package to provide spiritual comfort and hope for families in need. Total funds in the amount of \$100,000 are needed immediately to provide 2,000 emergency food packages for families in Ukraine.
- Action Bible New Testaments—In addition to the Scriptures included in the food packages, Mission Eurasia is making plans to immediately print and distribute 100,000 copies of the Action Bible New Testament for hurting and suffering children in Ukraine. In fact, we are taking a step of faith and starting the printing process now even before we have all of the funds needed so that these copies of Scripture can be made available to children in Ukraine as soon as possible. Each copy costs \$1.32, so the total cost to print 100,000 copies is \$132,000. But since a generous family in Canada recently offered to match every dollar up to \$60,000 for this project, and additional donations have been received, the remaining amount needed for the Action Bible New Testaments is \$50,000.



Even if a new Russian invasion and war do not break out in Ukraine, there is still an enormous need for humanitarian food aid and Scripture for the people of Ukraine from the first Russian invasion in 2014.

That's why I am earnestly asking you to pray and consider a generous gift to provide immediate physical and spiritual help for suffering families in Ukraine through our "I Care" Refugee Assistance program. We are depending on your generous support and prayers to help us meet the needs of those hardest hit by war and unrest in my homeland.
